Heart beats kannada movie songs

Tiziana Nanni/Getty Images Both the hurtful sting of a breakup or having to be the one to do the unpleasant task of breaking up with someone are situations that can really benefit from a songwriter who knows about pain, puts your pain in words and sometimes even helps calm a broken heart. Breakup songs over the decades help heal the heartache that can leave an empty feeling in the pit of the stomach, the feeling of hopelessness and lack of willingness to continue. Artists like Mary J. Blige, Ne-Yo, and the late Amy Winehouse are known for their deplorable tales of heartache. The 12 songs on this list represent some of the better modern and classic songs about being devastated. Do You, which was the second single from Ne-Yo's second album, Because of You in 2007, is a story about a man who goes through some serious emotional trauma because he still hasn't gotten over his ex and can't get her out of his mind. The text takes the form of a letter he writes to his former love, who has just had a child with another man and is now engaged: Swear I am not trying to start any problems. Tell your fiancé he can relax. I'll leave you alone for good I promise. There's one question I just have to ask, he says. I was just wondering, do you ever think about me anymore? Are you going to do that? You wouldn't normally associate Sade with the 1970s hard rock band Thin Lizzy, but that changed with her tender, a wistful remake of Thin Lizzy's Still in Love With You that appeared on her 2011 The Ultimate Collection. Important lyrics from the song: Think I'll just fall to pieces if I don't find anything else to do. This grief never ceases, I'm still in love with you. The highlight of Fantasia's 2010 album Back to Me is the first single, Bittersweet, during which Fantasia squirms over a former lover that she can't get out of her mind or heart, even though he treated her badly: Part of me wants you, part of me not, part of me is missin' you, part of me is gone, she sings. C.J. Hilton is a soulful artist who collaborated with Raphael Saadiq and Stevie Wonder. On the title song from his 2012 Cold Summer EP, he laments lost love over a thumping beat. Marvin Gaye and Curtis Mayfield would be proud of Hilton's soulful tribute and dead-on heartbreak lyrics. On his modernized doo-wop-style song I Need You, soul singer Mayer Hawthorne sadly regrets how he let his woman get away, and how much he needs her back in his life. Key lyric: When I saw you last night, it brought memories back to life. Of how we used to love each other, so sad that we didn't go any further. Arista Records The first person lyrics in Not Gon' Cry by Mary J. Blige, a story about a devastated wife, were written by a man, Babyface. Blige sings: While all the time that I loved you, you were busy loving yourself. I'd stop breathing if you told me to. Now you are love someone else. Eleven years of my life, except for the children, I have nothing to show. Wasted my years a poking fun at a one I should have left your ass a long time ago. Toni Braxton's finest moment as a singer came when she managed to reach the lowest of the lows emotionally on Un-Break My Heart. The text asks a former lover to come back and undo the pain they have caused. Braxton's interpretation was so powerful that it won a Grammy Award for Best Female Pop Song Performance. Unfortunately, the deep blue Back To Black by Amy Winehouse is tragically autobiographical. The song is about going into a deep depression after being left for an ex. He left no time for regret, kept his (thing) wet with his same old safe card, Winehouse sings mournfully. Alice Russell, one of Britain's finest soul singers, released Heartbreaker in late 2012. It's a song about having a hopelessly broken heart. Now I know when hearts are broken, that over time they heal, or so they say, Russell sings. But this holds on to me, I'm just suffocating to breathe, another kiss I'm praying. As Ne-Yo shows on So Sick, it doesn't get more real or sad than not changing your answering message so you can still hear the voice of the person who broke your heart when they moved out. I'm so tired of love songs so sad and slow, sings he. So why can't I turn off the radio? Not all broken heart songs have to leave you completely down in dumps, something that Jazmine Sullivan reminds us of Bust Your Windows. It's a delightfulevil evil song about getting revenge on a cheater. As she sings in the introduction: I bust the windows out your car. And no, it didn't mend my broken heart, I'll probably always have those ugly scars. But right now, I don't care about that part. Hi Records How can you mend a broken heart, the song title says it all. This is the kind of song you want to listen to while drowning your sorrows in a bottle of whiskey. Painful though the song is, it is also arguably the most brilliant moment in Al Green's long, glorious career. The Bee Gees composed and recorded this song first, but Rev. Al did it best. The singer/women's active wear designer/world dominator is just one of many music artists to have their songs turned into grindhouse movie posters. MusiXploitation is a series of posters for movies that are only found in the heart of rabid fans. In the late 90s, Master P would release full-length storytelling films with the same titles as his album, which were kind of fictional precursors to Lemonade with some seriously fraught dialogue. This new series is a glimpse of the world where practice is caught on with the entire music industry. The series was created by Paris-based art director David Redon and includes blaxploitation-style posters for songs and albums by Amy Winehouse, 2Pac and Jay-Z. (Previously, Redon had mashed up musicians with vintage ads.) Some are thematically appropriate, like Frank Ocean's galactic, eerie Pyramids, and others would no doubt make their namesake so very upset, as Miseducation of Lauryn Hill turns into a bikini bank heist caper. Like the recent Quentin Tarantino book cover featured on Co.Create, some of the entries are tainted with almost comically poor photoshop.
